The Bay Dental Practice offers a dental experience which is relaxing, friendly and where your child's needs come first. We aim to be pro-active in the prevention of tooth decay and gum disease through the use of proven preventive techniques and individually tailored health promotion advice. Today's youngsters can benefit from the significant advances made in the prevention of dental disease - giving them a smile they can be proud of for the rest of their lives.

Many of our adult patients benefit from the advantages of a preventive based membership plan. We have now joined with DPAS Limited to extend this opportunity to the whole family, allowing us to reward and look after our younger patients who attend the practice regularly. This plan is administered by DPAS, who will make a separate arrangement with you to manage your payments under the plan. Joining entitles your child to regular dental care and access to our clinical team when needed, as well as a range of additional benefits.



Additional Benefits

- a warranty on any dental work at the practice
- treatment planning to promote good dental health for life
- screening for mouth cancer and dental diseases
- access to a 24 hour dental emergency helpline 365 days per year.



We offer 2 levels of membership

Children (6-12 years) cost £6.00 per month and covers:

- 1 dental health examination per year
- 2 preventive visits (hygienist/therapist) for diet advice and toothbrushing instruction.

Teenagers (13-18 years) cost £8.00 per month and covers:

- 1 dental health examination per year
- 2 preventive visits (hygienist/therapist) for diet advice and toothbrushing instruction
- sports gum shields at laboratory cost (only laboratory fees to pay).

Both levels also include:

- free orthodontic assessments
- free small x-rays*
- free fluoride applications*
- 20% off fissure sealants
- 20% off white fillings
- 20% off crowns
- membership card with 24 hour helpline numbers for dental emergencies at home or abroad
- worldwide Supplementary Dental Injury and Emergency Insurance (see overleaf).

* where clinically necessary.

Infant Membership (0-5 years) is **free** for children whose parents benefit from adult membership. There are no insurance benefits provided by the Infant Membership. Details are in the adult membership brochure.

Membership numbers are limited so that we can maintain our level of customer service.

The monthly plan cost includes the charges for management and administration payable by you to DPAS.

Treatment not covered by this plan can be paid for separately.

How your child can become a member

There is no need for an assessment. All you have to do is complete a registration form for us and a Direct Debit mandate and authorisation form for DPAS, on behalf of your child.

In addition to your first monthly payment, an initial registration fee of £10 per child will be payable by you to DPAS and will be included in your first Direct Debit payment.

How do I end my child's membership?

Membership is a 12 month commitment. If you wish to end your child's Membership after that, you can do so by simply giving us one month's notice (*where membership is cancelled within the first 12 months, you will be invoiced for any discounts received*).

What does the Supplementary Insurance cover?

Your Supplementary Insurance provides:

- ✓ cover for:
 - up to £10,000 worth of treatment following dental injury
 - temporary emergency treatment whilst away from home in the UK or abroad (up to the limits specified)
 - the call-out fee charged by a dentist opening their surgery to treat you in an emergency (up to the limits specified)
- ✓ hospital cash benefit if under the care of an oral/maxillofacial surgeon
- ✓ cash benefit if diagnosed with oral cancer
- ✓ 24 hour access to a worldwide emergency helpline

The Supplementary Insurance is designed to cover the cost of **temporary emergency treatment whilst you are away from home** and therefore excludes the cost of emergency treatment carried out by your own dentist, a rota dentist, or any other dentist within a 15 mile radius of your practice. However, call-out fees charged by any dentist to open their surgery (including your own dentist) are recoverable up to policy limits.

In the event of a dental injury, treatment carried out by any dentist (including your own dentist) is covered up to policy limits.

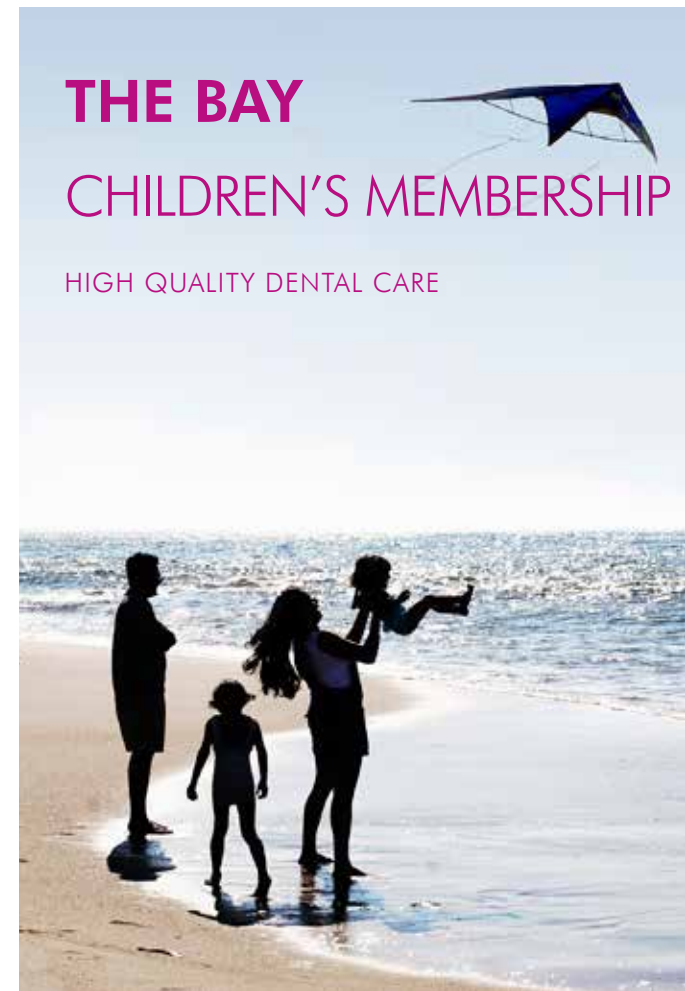
